Who we are

- We are all full members of Lake District Mountain Rescue Teams who are dedicated to training dogs to search for missing people.
- The Lake District Mountain Rescue Search Dogs is a registered charity and a specialist team that are available to all the Mountain Rescue Teams and the Police.

What we do

- Search dogs and handlers are amongst the first to be alerted by the teams and police to go out looking when there is a call-out for a missing person. We work often at night and in bad weather.
- We also regularly assist the police to search in other environments. We often look for children, despondent people and the elderly.
- We typically attend sixty to seventy searches annually.



Do you know?

- That dog handlers are all unpaid volunteers.
- That we are on call 24hrs, 365 days a year.
- That Lakes Search Dogs is entirely funded by donations from individuals like you.
- That we do need your support to fund training, clothing & equipment of handlers, dogs and volunteer 'dogsbodies'.
